PARENT'S GUIDE TO... ART SHOW



Art Show is the main fundraiser for First Presbyterian Preschool. It showcases individual artwork created by each child in every age group, as well as class collaborations and projects. The success of the event relies on the dedicated work of the preschool staff, the Board and its volunteers. The event is held at the International Museum of Art.





DETAILS...

Cup/Napkin Sponsorship: Parents have the opportunity to have their child's unique art work on the cups and napkins of the fundraiser event. This is a special sponsorship item, that will become a keepsake for the family and be used at our evening event.

Invitations: About six weeks prior to the event you will receive an invitation to the fundraiser, with your own child's special artwork showcased inside.

The children's art work showcase the Art Show event, but the evening event fundraiser also includes...

Silent Auction: Donated baskets, art, gift certificates to local businesses and other many fun items, will be offered. Winner will be able to take their items home with them the night of the event.

Live Auction: A live-auctioneer and MC head up the live auction portion of the evening. Which includes the Class Projects, Party on the Playground & any other large ticket items. Its a fun and fast paced run-off to see who makes it to the end.

ART SHOW 101

Art Show typically takes place in mid-April every year and the art work is professionally displayed in the museum for two weeks. The show is kicked off with a dressy evening fundraiser event for adults only which includes, live & silent auctions, appetizers, drinks and much more. Each year the show has a theme picked by the Art Show Committee, which encompasses the entire event. The children's art work will be on display for two weeks at the museum and the Three's-Kindergartners will have a class field trip to see their masterpieces during the exposition.

INDIVIDUAL ART: DISPLAY ONLY

Each child works hard to create an individual piece of art for the show, in a variety of mediums such as, but not limited to: painting, collage, watercolor, pencil, construction, sculpture etc. With the facilitation of the teachers, each student's art is created on their own and displayed in the museum. At the end of the show, each child gets to take their art work home.

CLASS COLLABORATIONS: SILENT AUCTION

Each class with the leadership of the Art Show Committee and Room Parent volunteers, works to create a piece of art work in any medium, with each child's participation, name etc. on the final product. This year, we will be collaborating with local art students and artists to foster the creativity of our kids. Each masterpiece will be up for auction.

CLASS PROJECTS: LIVE AUCTION

Each class works in conjunction with the Art Show Committee, the Director and volunteers to create a group project with every child's special touch for our live auction. In the past these template items have been anything from a bookcase, playhouse, tepee, lemonade stand, play kitchen etc.
